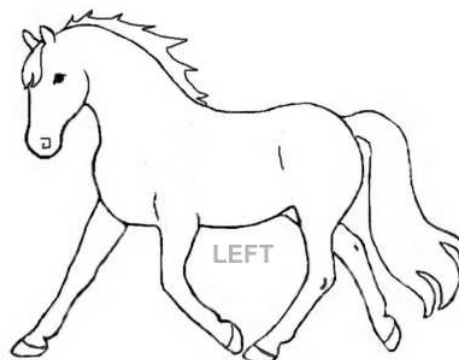
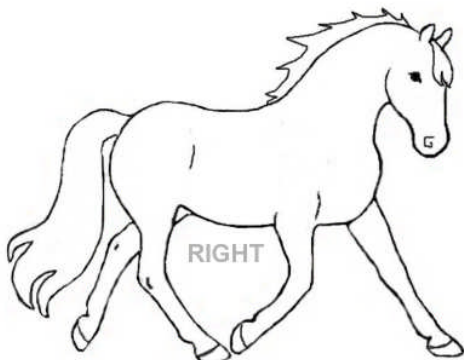

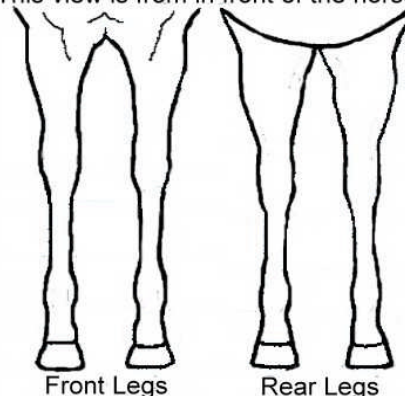

DNA has become the industry standard for all credible registries. Some show circuits, such as International Friesian Show Horse Association (IFSHA), require DNA before you can show. It is important to know that there is no test to determine if a horse is of a particular breed. Comparing DNA from an offspring to its parent(s) is the only valid way to determine ancestry. It is essential to maintain unbroken DNA links, through the generations, in order to preserve and authenticate a bloodline. Beware of registries that DNA test without parent verification. DNA markers alone, without the parent verification, cannot substantiate lineage. **DNA can be used to identify a horse if its papers are lost or if it is confused with another.**

K DNA PARENT VERIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

HH strongly recommends that all horses of Friesian Heritage be DNA tested at the time of registration!

If the horse has not been DNA tested, "Not Verified" will be written on their papers.

Although DNA is not required for all horses at this time, it is required for the following:

◆ Purebred Friesians, all Specialty Book horses and horses showing IFSHA:

Must be DNA tested with HH OR registered and DNA tested with another credible registry.

We can accept copies of existing DNA parentage markers from most registries, but conversion fees may be applied.

◆ Sires & Dams:

 In most cases, breeding horses of Friesian ancestry, must have DNA on file, before their offspring can be registered with HH.

Please choose one of the following: A laminated copy of the results will be mailed, at the same time as the registration certificate.

- I WISH TO ORDER DNA marker/parentage test, along with registration.
- I WISH TO ORDER DNA marker/parentage and dwarfism / hydrocephalus tests, with registration. Plus distichiasis.
- I DO NOT WISH to order DNA testing at this time. I am supplying the required **hair sample** to be placed on file with HH
- Horse has been previously DNA tested and I am supplying a **hair sample** and copy of the markers or UC Davis case number: _____

* For dwarfism, hydrocephalus and distichiasis, only tests conducted through HH, UC Davis, FHANA / KFPS will be recognized. "NQ tests" from UC Davis can be accepted after a \$15 horse verification fee is paid, to ensure it is the correct horse.

Note: In order to conduct parent verification tests, a \$25 DNA conversion fee may be required for any horses that were not tested through HH.

In some cases, a conversion fee(s) may also be required on the sire and/or dam of horse being registered. **All hair submitted becomes the property of HH.**

A HAIR SAMPLE IS MANDATORY!

(Even if you are supplying DNA markers)



Do NOT put the hair in a plastic bag!

Pull 40 to 50 mane hairs out by the roots!

Do NOT cut the hair from the horse or use body hair.

Do NOT touch or place tape on root ends.

◀ Roots of hair must be placed in this white box.
Tape the shafts of the hair, coil if necessary.

Attach hair to this form only. DO NOT put hair inside a plastic bag or envelope!
