| ▶ IMPORTANT TEST FOR BREEDING HORSES Dwarfism & Hydrocephalus are dangerous genetic abnormalities that are prevalent in Friesians, and now found in crossbreds. It is only if you breed this horse, that carrier status matters. If you breed to another carrier parent, the foal has a 1 in 4 (25%) chance of having dwarfism or hydrocephalus. Being a carrier DOES NOT affect the health of a horse! (See HH website) | | |
